Requirements for National Graduate Scholarship Award:

1. Applicants must be minority students in their first, second, third, or fourth year enrolled full-time in an accredited undergraduate business or management program during the fall semester of 2008 (Aug/Sept), or the winter semester of 2009 (Jan) working toward a bachelor's degree.
2. Applicants must submit a two-page (double-spaced, 12-point font) type-written essay in response to one of the topics below:
 - a. What recommendations would you give to Business Schools that want to redesign their recruitment strategies to attract minority candidates? Once enrolled, what resources or programs should be offered to help retain minority students?
 - b. What can African Americans do to become more marketable in the global economy?
3. Mail official stamped transcripts from all graduate institutions listed.
