**Requirements for Metro New York Chapter of the National Black MBA
Scholarship Award:**

Applicants must:

1. Be a minority full time student (12 semester hours) enrolled in accredited undergraduate or graduate business programs in NY Metro area at the time the scholarship award is received in December 2009.
2. Participate in 5 hours of community service and/or extra-curricular activities.
3. Submit an essay on specified subject matter.
4. Submit an official stamped college transcript.
5. Submit 2 letters of recommendation.
6. Must be able to attend Scholarship Award on December 18, 2009 to receive award.
7. Provide a personal biography and professional picture upon notification that award is being received.
8. **Submit a completed application postmarked and electronically submitted no later than October 31, 2009**
